3. Pray for a change in culture

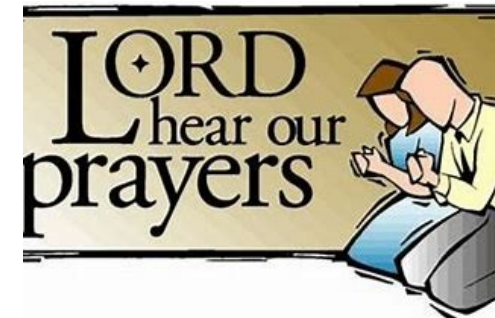
