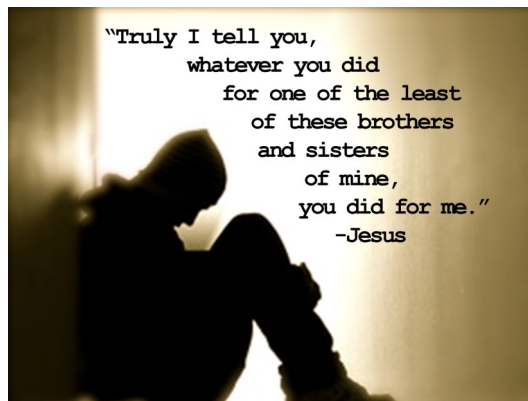

The leadership team has decided to open the church fully for worship on the first Sunday in September. The last Zoom service will be on 25 July, and we are planning some 'summertime specials' on Sunday mornings in August.

The **next church meeting**, which will also be the AGM, will be on **Thursday 22 July at 7.30 pm** in the centre. There will be a vote on nominations for deacon, which must be received by **4 July**.

Open Doors ranks **China** at No. 17 on its World Watch List of 50 countries where Christians are most persecuted. The Chinese Communist Party is concerned about Christianity growing and is trying to control the church by using mass surveillance technology, artificial intelligence, and cameras forcibly installed inside church buildings, offering boxes, and Bible-selling counters. There is also an officially approved Chinese Bible translation.
